


One of the greatest Italian living photographers.

The most prominent and "social" African-American film director With two Academy Award nominations, a Lifetime Achievement Honor at the César Awards and a "star" in the Walk of Fame in Hollywood, he is now the most famous African-American director. His films, milestones of cinema in the world, reflect in an original way, through content and language, his commitment to artistic and political issues of fundamental social importance, such as race relations and civil rights. An all-round and eclectic figure, Lee is also a screenwriter, film producer, documentary film maker and musician. In 2005 he published his autobiography, entitled: "That's my story and I'm sticking to it". He is the creator of the hit television series *House of Cards*, taken from his trilogy of political thrillers. Prominent figure of the English political panorama, former adviser to Margaret Thatcher, he is now a member of the House of Lords. Among his books, the novel *Winston's War*, dedicated to the figure of Churchill. The London Times called him "an heir of the narrative tradition of Shakespeare", for his accurate and detailed portrait of the historical events of the past.
